10. Executive Summary

10.1. Park Improvements and Enhancements

A general summary of the plans is included in Chapter 9 and the Appendix C Maps and Plans. The proposed park improvements and enhancements, discussed thoroughly during the preparation of this Plan, are intended to benefit Marcus Hook Borough residents and stakeholders over the next 20 years. Each park is proposed to be improved and enhanced based on the collective input of Borough residents and stakeholders.

10.2. Open Spaces and Natural Resources

A general summary of the plans is included in Chapter 9 and the Appendix C Maps and Plans. The proposed open spaces and natural resources are intended to benefit the Borough by expanding the existing network of park and recreation facilities. The Borough intends to pursue the expansion of the park system with the cooperation of the private sector.

10.3. Pedestrian Amenities/Walkable Community

A general summary of the plans is included in Chapter 9 and the Appendix C Maps and Plans. The proposed pedestrian amenities are intended to broaden the scope of the green infrastructure of the Borough for the benefit of residents and stakeholders of all ages and abilities. New sidewalks and walkways along the relocated Penn Avenue will enable improved Pedestrian access on the east side of the Borough.

10.4. Street Trees and Green Streets

Street trees to be maintained, replaced, and added will promote and enhance the Streetscapes and Green Streets of Marcus Hook.

Given the extensive nature of the industrial development along the western and eastern portions of the Borough, Street Trees will provide a welcome canopy to unify the neighborhoods, add shade, improve air quality, and increase attractiveness of the public realm of the Borough.

Marcus Hook Borough has achieved the status of "Tree City USA" for the past 37 years, and intends to continue as a designated "Tree City USA" into the future.

10. Executive Summary

10.5. Scenic Views & Beautification

The Fishing Pier at Market Square Memorial Park will be replaced to provide wonderful views of the passing ships along the Delaware River, to give residents the opportunity to catch fish, and to enjoy picnicking.

In addition, the Riverfront Promenade along the edge of Market Square Memorial Park will continue to offer expansive views of the Delaware River, especially from the 7 benches along the Promenade that have been maintained since 1986.

10.6. Community Recreational Programming

Increased programming is proposed through recruitment of volunteers, especially parents. In addition, the Borough should consider hiring a Year-Round, Part -Time Recreation Director within the next 10 years.

10.7. Heritage Tourism & Gateway Features

Heritage Tourism will continue at Market Square Memorial Park, with the annual Pirate Festival. In addition, by creating a new Gateway Plaza along 10th Street very close to the Delaware/Pennsylvania line, the Borough will be able to affirm its status as the "Cornerstone of Pennsylvania".

10.8. Recreation Fee-in-Lieu Program

A Recreation Fee-in-Lieu program is outlined in Appendix E. Essentially, the Borough will need to utilize this Plan as the "Approved Recreation Plan" in the context of a Subdivision & Land Development Ordinance Amendment.

Community Meeting #1 was held on March 13, 2023 at Marcus Hook Borough Hall. Over 30 people provided input to this Mini-PROS Plan. Community Meeting #2 was held on June 12, 2023 with 8 people attending.



- e. We need new Play Apparatus at Market Square Memorial Park.
- f. We need an additional Pavilion at Market Square Memorial Park.
- g. We need bathrooms at Market Square Memorial Park.
- h. We need to create an ADA Accessible opportunity at Market Square Memorial Park for persons that are visually impaired.
- We need to expand the Summer Concerts and add concerts for children at Market Square Memorial Park.
- j. We need to replace the picnic tables at Mickey Vernon Park/Playground.
- k. We need more shade at the Playground at Mickey Vernon Park.
- I. We need more recreational programs for children 13 years old to 15 years old.
- m. We need to reinstitute a Sumer Recreation Program for children.
- n. We need additional PAL type programs by the Police with the children.
- o. We need a basketball court across from the Borough Police Station.
