PLACE CLAY BASED KITTY LITTER IN A HEFTY TRASH BAG AND ADD PAINT & MIX TOGETHER. ONCE IT IS COMPLETELY DRIED YOU CAN DISPOSE OF IT IN YOUR REGULAR TRASH.

DROP OFF GUIDELINES:

- ❖ BUSINESSES AND CONTRACTORS WILL BE TURNED AWAY-HOUSEHOLD DISPOSAL ONLY
- ❖ BRING ALL SUBSTANCES IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINERS. ITEMS MUST BE IDENTIFIABLE.
DO NOT MIX MATERIALS
- ❖ TIGHTEN LIDS ON ALL CONTAINERS. IF CONTAINER IS LEAKING, PACK IN LARGER CONTAINER WITH NEWSPAPER TO ABSORB FLUID.
- ❖ NO 25 OR 50 GALLON DRUMS
- ❖ PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR CAR...EVENT WORKERS WILL UNLOAD YOUR ITEMS.
- ❖ THERE ARE NO ONGOING PUBLIC DROP OFF LOCATIONS IN OUR REGION FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE.
- ❖ DROP OFFS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. ONLY 1 APPOINTMENT PER VEHICLE REQUIRED
- ❖ MUST PRESENT TICKET UPON ARRIVAL
